- 1 AN ACT in relation to air transportation.
- 2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,
- 3 represented in the General Assembly:
- 4 Section 5. The Illinois Aeronautics Act is amended by
- 5 adding Sections 46.1, 46.2, 46.3, 46.4, 46.5, 46.6, 46.7, and
- 6 46.8 as follows:
- 7 (620 ILCS 5/46.1 new)
- 8 <u>Sec. 46.1. Air schools must be licensed.</u>
- 9 (a) A person may not operate an air school in this State
- 10 <u>unless the person holds an annual license issued by the</u>
- 11 <u>Department</u>.
- 12 (b) Upon receipt of an application and a \$25 license fee
- 13 from an air school, the Department must review the
- 14 qualifications of the applicant.
- (c) An air school license expires one year from date of
- 16 <u>issuance</u>, <u>unless</u> <u>surrendered</u>, <u>suspended</u>, <u>or revoked before</u>
- 17 that date, or upon the sale or transfer, by the owner, of the
- 18 property, equipment, or franchise of the air school.
- 19 <u>(d) The annual air school license renewal fee is \$10 and</u>
- 20 <u>is payable from the original date of issuance. An applicant</u>
- 21 <u>must file an initial application and pay the initial</u>
- 22 <u>application fee if the license is not renewed before its</u>
- 23 <u>expiration</u>.
- (e) A change in the name of the air school, without
- 25 <u>change in ownership, does not void a current license if the</u>
- 26 <u>owner of the air school notifies the Department in writing</u>
- 27 <u>within 15 days of the change. Upon receipt of notification</u>
- 28 <u>under this subsection, the Department must issue a license</u>
- 29 <u>under the new name, with the same expiration date as the</u>
- 30 <u>license previously issued.</u>
- 31 <u>(f) An air school operating facilities at more than one</u>

- 1 <u>airport must obtain a license for each location.</u>
- 2 (q) The air school license must be posted in the
- 3 principal office of the air school, where it may be readily
- 4 <u>observed by the general public.</u>
- 5 (h) The requirements of this Section, and the following
- 6 <u>Sections preceding Section 47, for an air school are</u>
- 7 <u>conditions of the license</u>. Failure to comply with any of
- 8 these requirements is grounds for revocation of an air
- 9 <u>school's license.</u>
- 10 (i) A person who violates this Section or any of the
- 11 <u>following Sections preceding Section 47, except as provided</u>
- 12 <u>in Section 46.8, is guilty of a Class B misdemeanor</u>
- 13 punishable by imprisonment for not more than 90 days, a fine
- of not more than \$500, or both.
- 15 (620 ILCS 5/46.2 new)
- Sec. 46.2. General requirements for air school operation.
- 17 (a) An air school must conduct itself in accordance with
- 18 <u>all applicable federal and State statutes and rules and all</u>
- 19 <u>applicable local ordinances.</u>
- 20 (b) An air school must be operated from an airport
- 21 properly licensed by the Department.
- 22 (c) An air school operator must obtain from the airport
- 23 <u>manager a written agreement to operate commercially from the</u>
- 24 airport at which the air school is based.
- 25 (d) Each air school student must be advised in writing
- 26 at the time of enrollment of the type and amount of insurance
- 27 <u>coverage provided for each aircraft used by the air school.</u>
- 28 (e) An air school must provide a suitable space of
- 29 permanent nature that is properly heated, lighted, and
- 30 <u>ventilated to accommodate air school students and to house</u>
- 31 <u>adequate equipment necessary to properly conduct business</u>
- 32 <u>matters and to prepare and preserve business records. The</u>
- 33 <u>facilities described in this subsection must be located at</u>

- 1 <u>the licensed airport site.</u>
- 2 (620 ILCS 5/46.3 new)
- 3 <u>Sec. 46.3. Requirements for air school aircraft.</u>
- 4 (a) Each aircraft to be used for purposes of air
- 5 <u>instruction at an air school must comply with all of the</u>
- 6 <u>following:</u>
- 7 (1) Possess a valid airworthiness certificate
- 8 <u>issued by the Federal Aviation Administration.</u>
- 9 (2) Be properly registered with the Department.
- 10 <u>(3) Have the equipment and performance</u>
- characteristics appropriate to the curriculum and to the
- 12 <u>airport to be used.</u>
- 13 (b) All aircraft used in any air school operation must
- 14 be operated in accordance with Federal Aviation
- 15 Administration maintenance regulations and standards.
- 16 Adequate records must be kept by the school to demonstrate
- 17 performance of all required items of maintenance. The
- 18 <u>maintenance status of each aircraft, including discrepancies,</u>
- 19 <u>must be displayed by the school in a manner adequate to</u>
- 20 <u>determine compliance</u>.
- 21 (620 ILCS 5/46.4 new)
- 22 <u>Sec. 46.4. Air instruction requirements.</u>
- 23 <u>(a) An air school must have an aeronautics instructor</u>
- 24 <u>available to dispatch and supervise each student pilot solo</u>
- 25 flight.
- 26 <u>(b) An air school must have a written curriculum,</u>
- 27 <u>including lesson plans</u>, <u>adequate to properly qualify the</u>
- 28 <u>student to complete the particular course for the certificate</u>
- 29 <u>or rating sought. An air school must also include lessons</u>
- 30 pertaining to this Act and to other statutes and rules of
- 31 <u>this State relating to aviation.</u>
- 32 <u>(c) An air school must make available to students</u>

- 1 <u>current texts and reference material pertaining to the</u>
- 2 <u>certificate or rating sought.</u>
- 3 (d) An air school must provide adequate air instruction
- 4 to properly qualify a student completing its courses for the
- 5 <u>appropriate Federal Aviation Administration examination</u>
- 6 covering the certificate or rating sought.
- 7 <u>(e) An air school must maintain training records</u>
- 8 <u>adequate to show each student's progress and level of</u>
- 9 <u>completion relative to the course of air instruction in which</u>
- 10 the student is enrolled. These records must be made available
- 11 for inspection by any authorized representative of the
- 12 <u>Department</u>.
- 13 (f) A copy of the airport and air school rules must be
- 14 <u>made available to the students enrolled in the school for</u>
- 15 <u>information and guidance.</u>
- 16 (q) An air school must designate a practice area.
- 17 (620 ILCS 5/46.5 new)
- 18 <u>Sec. 46.5. Air school advertising requirements.</u>
- 19 <u>(a) An air school or its representatives and</u>
- 20 <u>instructors may not make false claims of any kind pertaining</u>
- 21 to either air instruction or employment following air
- 22 <u>instruction</u>.
- 23 (b) Only a licensed air school may advertise air
- 24 instruction.
- 25 (620 ILCS 5/46.6 new)
- Sec. 46.6. Air school bonding requirements.
- 27 (a) An air school accepting prepayment equal to or in
- 28 <u>excess of \$1,000 must file with the Department a corporate</u>
- 29 <u>surety bond payable to the State of Illinois in the sum of</u>
- 30 \$5,000, conditioned on the faithful performance of all
- 31 <u>contracts and agreements with students made by the air school</u>
- 32 <u>or its agent. The aggregate liability for the surety for all</u>

- 1 breaches of conditions of the bond may not exceed the
- 2 principal sum of \$5,000.
- 3 (b) The surety of any bond may cancel the bond upon
- 4 giving 60 days' notice in writing to the Department and the
- 5 <u>air school. If a bond is canceled in compliance with this</u>
- 6 Section, the surety is relieved of liability for any breach
- 7 of conditions occurring after the effective date of
- 8 <u>cancellation</u>.
- 9 (620 ILCS 5/46.7 new)
- 10 Sec. 46.7. Air school records checking requirements.
- 11 (a) An air school must request from the Department of
- 12 <u>State Police a criminal history check and criminal records</u>
- 13 <u>check through the Federal Bureau of Investigation on any</u>
- 14 applicant for training at the air school. The applicant must
- 15 <u>cooperate with the air school in completing the criminal</u>
- 16 <u>history check and criminal records check through the Federal</u>
- 17 <u>Bureau of Investigation</u>.
- 18 (b) An air school may not enroll, or must terminate the
- 19 <u>enrollment of, an applicant if any of the following occurred</u>
- 20 <u>to the applicant within the preceding 7 years:</u>
- 21 (1) Was convicted of a felony.
- 22 (2) Was incarcerated for a felony conviction.
- 23 (3) Was on probation or parole for a felony
- 24 conviction.
- 25 (625 ILCS 5/46.8 new)
- Sec. 46.8. Air school applicants' records.
- 27 <u>(a) Except as provided in subsections (c) and (e), as a</u>
- 28 <u>condition of enrollment of an applicant in an air school, the</u>
- 29 <u>air school must request from the Department of State Police a</u>
- 30 <u>criminal history check and a criminal records check through</u>
- 31 the Federal Bureau of Investigation on the applicant and,
- 32 <u>before enrolling the applicant, must have received from the</u>

- 1 Department of State Police the report described in subsection
- 2 <u>(h)</u>.
- 3 (b) An air school must require the applicant to submit
- 4 <u>his or her fingerprints to the Department of State Police for</u>
- 5 the criminal history and criminal records checks. The air
- 6 school may charge the air school applicant a fee for the
- 7 <u>criminal history check and the criminal records check. The</u>
- 8 <u>Department of State Police may charge a fee for the criminal</u>
- 9 <u>history check and the criminal records check.</u>
- 10 <u>(c) The air school may enroll the applicant as a</u>
- 11 <u>conditional student under this subsection without first</u>
- 12 receiving the report described in subsection (h) if all of
- 13 <u>the following apply:</u>
- 14 (1) The air school requests the criminal history
- and criminal records checks required under subsection (a)
- before conditionally enrolling the applicant.
- 17 (2) The applicant signs a statement that identifies
- all crimes of which he or she has been convicted, if any,
- 19 <u>and agreeing that, if the report described in subsection</u>
- 20 (h) is not the same as the applicant's statement, his or
- 21 <u>her enrollment contract is void. If the statement of</u>
- 22 <u>convictions includes any of the circumstances described</u>
- in Section 46.7, the enrollment contract is void.
- 24 (d) If an applicant is enrolled as a conditional student
- 25 under subsection (c) and the report described in subsection
- 26 (h) is not the same as the applicant's statement under
- 27 <u>subsection (c), the air school must void the applicant's</u>
- 28 <u>enrollment contract. If the contract is voided under this</u>
- 29 <u>subsection</u>, the applicant's enrollment is terminated and the
- 30 air school is not liable for the termination or any money
- 31 <u>paid toward enrollment.</u>
- 32 (e) If an applicant for enrollment is being considered
- 33 for enrollment by more than one air school and if the
- 34 applicant agrees in writing to allow an air school to share

- 1 the report described in subsection (h) with another air
- 2 school, the air school may satisfy the requirements of
- 3 subsection (a) by obtaining a copy of the report described in
- 4 subsection (h) from another air school.
- 5 (f) An applicant described in subsection (a) must give
- 6 written consent at the time of application for the Department
- 7 of State Police to conduct the criminal history and criminal
- 8 records check required under this Section.
- 9 (g) An air school must make a request to the Department
- 10 <u>of State Police for a criminal history and criminal records</u>
- 11 <u>check required under this Section on a form and in a manner</u>
- 12 prescribed by the Department of State Police.
- (h) Within 30 days after receiving a proper request by
- 14 <u>an air school for a criminal history and criminal records</u>
- check on an applicant under this Section, the Department of
- 16 State Police must conduct and initiate the criminal history
- 17 <u>and criminal records check and, after conducting the criminal</u>
- 18 <u>history and criminal records check and within that time</u>
- 19 period, provide a report of the results of the criminal
- 20 <u>history and criminal records check to the air school. The</u>
- 21 report must contain any criminal history record information
- 22 <u>on the applicant maintained by the Department of State Police</u>
- 23 and include information regarding the criminal records check
- of the records of the Federal Bureau of Investigation.
- 25 <u>(i) Criminal history and criminal records information</u>
- 26 received from the Department of State Police under subsection
- 27 (h) may be used by an air school only for the purpose of
- 28 <u>evaluating an applicant's qualifications for enrollment in</u>
- 29 the position for which he or she has applied and for the
- 30 purposes of subsection (d). An air school may not disclose
- 31 <u>the report or its contents to any person who is not directly</u>
- 32 <u>involved in evaluating the applicant's qualifications for</u>
- 33 <u>enrollment. A person described in subsection (e), however,</u>
- 34 may provide a copy of the report under subsection (h)

- 1 concerning the individual to an appropriate representative of
- 2 another air school.
- (j) A person who violates this Section is guilty of a 3
- Class C misdemeanor punishable by imprisonment for not more 4
- 5 than 30 days, a fine of not more than \$500, or both.
