- 1 AN ACT concerning teacher incentives.
- 2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,
- 3 represented in the General Assembly:
- 4 Section 5. The School Code is amended by adding Section
- 5 2-3.131 as follows:
- 6 (105 ILCS 5/2-3.131 new)
- 7 <u>Sec. 2-3.131. Quality teacher incentive program.</u>
- 8 (a) The State Board of Education shall implement and
- 9 <u>administer a quality teacher incentive program. Under this</u>
- 10 program, the State Board of Education shall provide, from
- 11 appropriations made for the purposes of this Section, a
- 12 signing bonus of \$1,500 to each eligible teacher.
- 13 (b) A teacher is eligible under this program if the
- 14 person has graduated from a regionally accredited institution
- in the top 25% of his or her class, has an Initial Teaching
- 16 <u>Certificate with a special certification designation for</u>
- 17 <u>mathematics or science, and agrees to teach the subject of</u>
- 18 <u>mathematics or science, whichever is applicable, in a public</u>
- 19 school in this State for a minimum of 3 consecutive years.
- 20 <u>(c) A teacher who has received a signing bonus under</u>
- 21 this program and leaves employment with the public school
- 22 <u>before the end of the 3-year commitment must reimburse the</u>
- 23 State in the amount of \$1,500, unless the teacher has left to
- 24 <u>accept a teaching position with another public school in this</u>
- 25 State.
- 26 (d) A teacher who receives a signing bonus under this
- 27 program shall not be deemed an employee of the State.
- 28 (e) The State Board of Education may adopt any rules
- 29 <u>necessary to carry out its responsibilities under this</u>
- 30 <u>Section</u>.
