- 4 Section 5. The Code of Criminal Procedure of 1963 is
- 5 amended by adding Article 107A as follows:

- 7 <u>ARTICLE 107A. LINEUP AND PHOTO SPREAD PROCEDURES</u>
- 8 <u>IN HOMICIDE CASES</u>
- 9 (725 ILCS 5/107A-5 new)
- 10 <u>Sec. 107A-5. Lineup and photo spread procedures in</u>
- 11 <u>homicide cases.</u>
- 12 (a) For a homicide offense alleged to have been
- 13 committed on or after the effective date of this amendatory
- 14 Act of the 93rd General Assembly, the lineup or photo spread
- 15 shall be conducted to insure that all persons in the lineup
- or photo spread fit the general description of the suspect.
- 17 (b) Whenever possible, the lineup or photo spread
- 18 <u>administrator in a homicide case shall be someone who is not</u>
- 19 <u>aware of which member of the lineup or photo spread is the</u>
- 20 <u>suspect in the case. Prior to presenting the lineup or photo</u>
- 21 <u>spread</u>, the lineup or photo spread administrator shall:
- 22 (1) inform the witness that the perpetrator may or

- (d) This Section applies to any live lineups in homicide 3
