AN ACT making appropriations and reappropriations.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,represented in the General Assembly:

Section 5. The amount of \$45,901,400, or so much thereof 4 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue 5 Fund to the Board of Trustees of Eastern Illinois University б 7 to meet the ordinary and contingent expenses of the University, including payment or reimbursement to the 8 9 University for personal services and related costs, incurred during the fiscal year ending June 30, 2004 and for salaries 10 accrued but unpaid to academic personnel for personal 11 services rendered during the FY 2003 academic year. 12

13 Section 10. The amount of \$7,154,200, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Education 14 Assistance Fund to the Board of Trustees of Eastern Illinois 15 University to meet the ordinary and contingent expenses of 16 the University, including payment or reimbursement to the 17 18 University for personal services and related costs, incurred 19 during the fiscal year ending June 30, 2004 and for salaries accrued but unpaid to academic personnel for personal 20 services rendered during the FY 2003 academic year. 21

22 Section 15. The sum of \$665,700, or so much thereof as 23 may be necessary and remains unexpended at the close of 24 business on June 30, 2003, from a reappropriation heretofore 25 made for such purpose in Article 6, Section 15 of Public Act 26 92-538, is reappropriated from the Capital Development Fund 27 to Eastern Illinois University for digitalization 28 infrastructure for WEIU-TV.

29 Section 20. The sum of \$175,250, or so much thereof as

1 may be necessary and remains unexpended at the close of 2 business on June 30, 2003, from a reappropriation heretofore made for such purpose in Article 6, Section 20 of Public Act 3 4 92-538, is reappropriated from the Capital Development Fund 5 to the Board of Trustees of Eastern Illinois University for 6 digitalization infrastructure for WEIU-TV, in addition to any 7 other amounts previously appropriated for such purpose for 8 this fiscal year. No contract shall be entered into or 9 obligation incurred for expenditure any from the appropriation made in this Section until after the purposes 10 11 and amounts have been approved in writing by the Governor.

25. The sum of \$632,900, or so much thereof as 12 Section may be necessary and remains unexpended at the close 13 of business on June 30, 2003, from a reappropriation heretofore 14 15 made for such purpose in Article 6, Section 30 of Public Act 92-538, is reappropriated from the Capital Development Fund 16 17 to the Board of Trustees of Eastern Illinois University to 18 purchase equipment for the renovation and expansion of Booth Library. No contract shall be entered into or obligation 19 20 incurred for any expenditure from the appropriation made in this Section until after the purposes and amounts have been 21 approved in writing by the Governor. 22

Section 30. The sum of \$5,430,400, or so much thereof as 23 24 may be necessary and remains unexpended at the close of on June 30, 2003, from an appropriation heretofore 25 business made for such purpose in Article 1, Section 19 of Public Act 26 27 92-717, is reappropriated from the Capital Development Fund 28 to the Board of Trustees of Eastern Illinois University to purchase equipment for the renovation and expansion of the 29 30 Fine Arts Center. No contract shall be entered into or expenditure 31 obligation incurred for any from the appropriation made in this Section until after the purposes 32

1 and amounts have been approved in writing by the Governor.

2 Section 35. The sum of \$2,000, or so much thereof as may 3 be necessary, is appropriated from the State College and 4 University Trust Fund to the Board of Trustees of Eastern 5 Illinois University for scholarship grant awards, in 6 accordance with Public Act 91-83.

7 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect on8 July 1, 2003.
