- 2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,
- 3 represented in the General Assembly:
- Section 5. The Illinois Public Aid Code is amended by 4
- 5 changing Section 5-4.1 as follows:
- 6 (305 ILCS 5/5-4.1) (from Ch. 23, par. 5-4.1)
- Sec. 5-4.1. Co-payments. The Department may by rule 7
- 8 provide that recipients under any Article of this Code <u>must</u>
- shall pay a fee as a co-payment for services. Co-payments 9
- may not exceed \$3 for brand name drugs, \$1 for other pharmacy 10
- services, and \$2 for physicians services, dental services, 11
- 12 services and supplies, chiropractic services,
