- 4 Section 5. The Public Utilities Act is amended by adding
- 5 Section 6-103.1 as follows:
- 6 (220 ILCS 5/6-103.1 new)
- 7 Sec. 6-103.1. Purchase of public utility by out-of-state
- 8 <u>company</u>.
- 9 <u>(a) An out-of-state company or an affiliate of an</u>
- 10 <u>out-of-state company may not enter into a transaction for the</u>
- 11 purchase of a public utility located in Illinois unless prior
- 12 <u>to the transaction, the Commission has held hearings and has</u>
- 13 <u>determined that the transaction will not be detrimental to</u>
- 14 the public interest or the interests of consumers and that
- the taxes collected by the utility from its ratepayers will
- be paid in full to the appropriate government entities.
- 17 <u>(b) The Department of Revenue shall review the taxes</u>
- 18 paid by the out-of-state company in Illinois during the
- 19 <u>2-year period before the acquisition and shall report its</u>
- 20 <u>findings to the Commission</u>.
