2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly: 3

ARTICLE 1

5	Section 1. The following named amounts, or so much

2 Section 2. The sum of \$100,000, or so much thereof as 3 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Agricultural 4 Premium Fund to the Office of Lieutenant Governor for all 5 costs associated with the Rural Affairs Council including any 6 grants or administration expenses.

7 Section 3. The sum of \$50,000, or so much thereof as may 8 be necessary, is appropriated from the Lieutenant Governor's 9 Grant Fund to the Office of Lieutenant Governor to be 10 expended in accordance with the terms and conditions upon 11 which such funds were received and in the exercise of the 12 powers or performance of the duties of the Office of the 13 Lieutenant Governor.

Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect on July 1, 2003.
