1 AN ACT in relation to insurance.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Illinois Insurance Code is amended by changing Section 355.1 as follows:
- 6 (215 ILCS 5/355.1) (from Ch. 73, par. 967.1)
