

## 93RD GENERAL ASSEMBLY State of Illinois 2003 and 2004 HB4169

## SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

65 ILCS 5/3.1-40-60

Amends the Illinois Municipal Code. Provides that an advisory referendum may be placed on the ballot by majority vote of a municipality's corporate authorities, rather than its city council members.

## Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Illinois Municipal Code is amended by changing Section 3.1-40-60 as follows:
- 6 (65 ILCS 5/3.1-40-60)
- Sec. 3.1-40-60. Advisory referenda. By a vote of the
- 8 majority of the corporate authorities members of the city
- 9 council, the corporate authorities the council may authorize an
- 10 advisory question of public policy to be placed on the ballot
- 11 at the next regularly scheduled election in the municipality.
- 12 The <u>corporate authorities</u> <del>city council</del> shall certify the
- 13 question to the proper election authority, which must submit
- 14 the question at an election in accordance with the Election
- Code.
