1 AN ACT concerning advisory referenda.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- 4 Section 5. The School Code is amended by changing Section
- 5 9-1 and by adding Section 9-1.2 as follows:
- 6 (105 ILCS 5/9-1) (from Ch. 122, par. 9-1)
- 7 Sec. 9-1. Scope of article. All school elections shall be
- 8 governed by the general election law of the State, except as
- 9 otherwise provided in Section 9-1.2.

- Sec. 9-1.2. Advisory referenda. By a vote of the majority
- of the members of the board of education, the board may
- 14 <u>authorize an advisory question of public policy to be placed on</u>
- the ballot at the next regularly scheduled election in the
- 16 <u>school district</u>. The board of education shall certify the
- 17 question to the proper election authority, which must submit
- 18 the question at an election in accordance with the Election
- 19 <u>Code</u>.
