AN ACT in relation to the regulation of professions.

2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, 3 represented in the General Assembly:

Section 5. The Illinois Dental Practice Act is amended by
changing Section 8.1 as follows:

6 (225 ILCS 25/8.1) (from Ch. 111, par. 2308.1)

(Section scheduled to be repealed on January 1, 2006)

Sec. 8.1. Permits for administration of general anesthesia 8 or parenteral conscious sedation. No licensed dentist shall 9 administer general anesthesia or conscious sedation without 10 first applying for and obtaining a permit for such purpose from 11 12 the Department. The Department shall issue such permit only after ascertaining that the applicant possesses the minimum 13 14 qualifications necessary to protect public safety. A person 15 with a dental degree who administers anesthesia or conscious sedation in an approved hospital training program under the 16 17 supervision of either a licensed dentist holding such permit or a physician licensed to practice medicine in all its branches 18 19 shall not be required to obtain such permit.
