SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

225 ILCS 410/3-7.1

Amends the Barber, Cosmetology, Esthetics, and Nail Technology Act of 1985. Makes a technical change in a Section concerning the inactive status of the license of a cosmetologist, cosmetology teacher, or cosmetology clinic teacher.

AN ACT in relation to the regulation of professions.

2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, 3 represented in the General Assembly:

4 Section 5. The Barber, Cosmetology, Esthetics, and Nail 5 Technology Act of 1985 is amended by changing Section 3-7.1 as 6 follows:

7 (225 ILCS 410/3-7.1) (from Ch. 111, par. 1703-7.1)

(Section scheduled to be repealed on January 1, 2006)

Sec. 3-7.1. Inactive Status; restoration from inactive 9 status. Any cosmetologist, cosmetology teacher, or cosmetology 10 clinic teacher who notifies the Department in writing on forms 11 prescribed by the Department, may elect to place his or her 12 license on an inactive status and shall, subject to rules of 13 14 the Department, be excused from payment of renewal fees until 15 he or she notifies the Department in writing of his or her desire to resume active status. 16

17 Any cosmetologist, cosmetology teacher, or cosmetology clinic teacher requesting restoration from inactive status 18 19 shall be required to pay the current renewal fee and to qualify for the restoration of his or her license, subject to rules of 20 the Department. A license shall not be restored from inactive 21 22 status unless the cosmetologist, cosmetology teacher, or 23 cosmetology clinic teacher requesting the restoration completes the number of hours of continuing education required 24 25 for renewal of a license under Section 3-7.

Any cosmetologist, cosmetology teacher, or cosmetology clinic teacher whose license is in an inactive status shall not practice in the State of Illinois.
