SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

15 ILCS 405/26 new

Amends the State Comptroller Act. Requires that the Comptroller notify the Auditor General, the Governor, and the 4 legislative leaders when a State agency is delinquent in meeting reporting requirements set by law. Effective immediately.

1 AN ACT concerning the State Comptroller.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- 4 Section 5. The State Comptroller Act is amended by adding
- 5 Section 26 as follows:
- 6 (15 ILCS 405/26 new)
- 7 Sec. 26. Delinquent reporting notification. When the
- 8 <u>Comptroller determines that a State agency is delinquent in</u>
- 9 reporting to the Office of Comptroller as required by law, the
- 10 Comptroller shall notify the Office of the Auditor General, the
- Office of the Governor, the Speaker and Minority Leader of the
- House of Representatives, and the President and Minority Leader
- of the Senate of the delinquency.
- 14 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon
- 15 becoming law.
