SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

35 ILCS 635/25

Amends the Telecommunications Infrastructure Maintenance Fee Act. Makes a technical change in a Section concerning collection, enforcement, and administration of the fee.

1 AN ACT concerning taxes.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- 4 Section 5. The Telecommunications Infrastructure
- 5 Maintenance Fee Act is amended by changing Section 25 as
- 6 follows:
- 7 (35 ILCS 635/25)
- 8 Sec. 25. Collection, enforcement, and administration of
- 9 State telecommunications infrastructure maintenance fees.
- 10 (a) A telecommunications retailer shall charge each
- 11 customer an additional charge equal to the State infrastructure
- 12 maintenance fee attributable to that customer's service
- 13 address. Such additional charge shall be shown separately on
- 14 <u>each</u> the bill to the each customer.
- 15 (b) The State infrastructure maintenance fee shall be
- designated as a replacement for the personal property tax and
- shall be remitted by the telecommunications retailer to the
- Department; provided, however, that the telecommunications
- 19 retailer may retain an amount not to exceed 2% of the State
- infrastructure maintenance fee paid to the Department, with a
- 21 timely paid and timely filed return to reimburse itself for
- 22 expenses incurred in collecting, accounting for, and remitting
- 23 the <u>State infrastructure maintenance</u> fee. All amounts herein
- 24 remitted to the Department shall be transferred to the Personal
- 25 Property Tax Replacement Fund in the State Treasury.
