SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

20 ILCS 1705/10

from Ch. 91 1/2, par. 100-10

Amends the Mental Health and Developmental Disabilities Administrative Act. Provides that, based on an examination of a person admitted to a facility of the Department of Human Services, the Department shall (instead of may) provide necessary medical, education, and rehabilitation services and shall (instead of may) arrange for a further assessment and referral to appropriate alcoholism or substance abuse services. Provides that the assessment and referral shall be made to a provider who is able to accept the person for referral and perform a further assessment within a clinically appropriate time.

- rehabilitation services, and \underline{shall} \underline{may} arrange for further 13
- assessment and referral of such persons to appropriate 14
- 15 alcoholism or substance abuse services. Further assessment and
- referral of such persons by the Department to appropriate 16
- alcoholism or substance abuse services shall be made to 17
- providers who are able to accept the persons for referral and
- 19 perform a further assessment within a clinically appropriate

- The Department shall not deny treatment and care to any 21
- person subject to admission to a facility under its control for 22
- treatment for a mental illness or developmental disability 23
- solely on the basis of their alcoholism, drug addiction or 24
- 25 abuse of other substances.
