AN ACT concerning public utilities.

2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, 3 represented in the General Assembly:

Section 5. The Public Utilities Act is amended by changing
Section 9-101 as follows:

6 (220 ILCS 5/9-101) (from Ch. 111 2/3, par. 9-101)

7 Sec. 9-101. All rates or other charges that are made, demanded or received by any product or commodity furnished or 8 to be furnished or for any service rendered or to be rendered 9 shall be just and reasonable. Every unjust or unreasonable 10 charge that are made, demanded or received for such product or 11 commodity or service is hereby prohibited and declared 12 13 unlawful. All rules and regulations that are made by a public 14 utility affecting or pertaining to its charges to the public 15 shall be just and reasonable.
