1 AN ACT concerning financial regulation.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Consumer Installment Loan Act is amended by changing Section 8 as follows:
- 6 (205 ILCS 670/8) (from Ch. 17, par. 5408)
- 7 Sec. 8. Annual license fee $\underline{:}$ expenses. Before the 15th day
- 8 of each December, a licensee must pay to the Director, and the
- 9 Department must receive, the annual license fee required by
- 10 Section 2 for the next succeeding calendar year. The license
- shall expire on the first of January unless the license fee has
- 12 been paid prior thereto.
- In addition to $\underline{\text{the}}$ such license fee, the reasonable expense
- of any examination, investigation or custody by the Director
- under any provisions of this Act shall be borne by the
- 16 licensee.
- 17 If a licensee fails to renew his or her license by the 31st
- day of December, it shall automatically expire and the licensee
- is not entitled to a hearing; however, the Director, in his or
- 20 her discretion, may reinstate an expired license upon payment
- of the annual renewal fee and proof of good cause for failure
- 22 to renew.
