Amends the Criminal Code of 1961. Makes a technical change in a Section concerning the definition of "offense" for the purpose of inchoate offenses.

## Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- 4 Section 5. The Criminal Code of 1961 is amended by changing
- 5 Section 8-6 as follows:
- 6 (720 ILCS 5/8-6) (from Ch. 38, par. 8-6)
- 7 Sec. 8-6. Offense. For the purposes of this Article,
- 8 "offense" <u>includes</u> <del>shall include</del> conduct which if performed in
- 9 another State would be criminal by the laws of that State and
- 10 which conduct if performed in this State would be an offense
- 11 under the laws of this State.
