1 AN ACT in relation to criminal law.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- 4 Section 5. The Criminal Code of 1961 is amended by changing
- 5 Section 1-3 as follows:
- 6 (720 ILCS 5/1-3) (from Ch. 38, par. 1-3)
- 7 Sec. 1-3. Applicability of common law. No conduct
- 8 constitutes an offense unless it is described as an offense in
- 9 this Code or in another statute of this State. However, this
- 10 provision does not affect the power of a court to punish for
- 11 contempt or to employ \underline{a} any sanction authorized by law for the
- 12 enforcement of an order or civil judgment.
