1 AN ACT in relation to unemployment.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Unemployment Insurance Act is amended by
- 5 changing Section 241 as follows:
- 6 (820 ILCS 405/241) (from Ch. 48, par. 351)
- 7 Sec. 241. <u>Before Prior to September 27</u>, 1959, "week" means
- 8 such period of seven consecutive days as the Director may by
- 9 regulation prescribe. On and after September 27, 1959, "week"
- 10 means
- 11 A. Calendar week, or
- B. Any seven consecutive day period with respect to which
- 13 no wages are payable to an individual and during which he
- 14 performs no services, which occurs within two calendar weeks in
- each of which he is not unemployed; or
- 16 C. Any seven consecutive day period which ends after
- September 26, 1959, and before October 3, 1959.
- The Director may by regulation prescribe that a week shall
- 19 be deemed to be "in," "within," or "during" any benefit year
- which includes the greater part of such week.
