Amends the Longtime Owner-Occupant Property Tax Relief Act concerning the public policy of the Act. Makes a technical change.

AN ACT concerning taxes.

2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, 3 represented in the General Assembly:

Section 5. The Longtime Owner-Occupant Property Tax Relief
Act is amended by changing Section 5 as follows:

6 (35 ILCS 250/5)

7 Sec. 5. Public policy. In recognition of the severe economic circumstances of certain longtime owner-occupants of 8 9 residences who are faced with rising living costs and constantly increasing tax burdens in areas where real property 10 values have risen markedly as a <u>result</u> consequence of the 11 renovation other deteriorating residences or 12 of the construction of new residences, the General Assembly considers 13 14 it to be a matter of sound public policy for counties having a 15 population of 100,000 or more to adopt uniform special real property tax relief provisions in order to allow longtime 16 17 owner-occupants of residences to remain in peaceful possession 18 of their homes.
