# Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Illinois Optometric Practice Act of 1987 is
  amended by changing Section 4 as follows:
- 6 (225 ILCS 80/4) (from Ch. 111, par. 3904)
- 7 (Section scheduled to be repealed on January 1, 2007)
- 8 Sec. 4. <u>Necessity of license.</u> No person shall practice<sub>7</sub> or
- 9 attempt to practice  $\tau$  optometry, as defined in this Act, without
- 10 a valid license as an optometrist issued by the Department.
