Amends the Nursing Home Care Act. Makes technical changes to a Section concerning do-not-resuscitate orders.

1 AN ACT concerning nursing home care.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Nursing Home Care Act is amended by changing Section 2-104.2 as follows:
- 6 (210 ILCS 45/2-104.2) (from Ch. 111 1/2, par. 4152-104.2)
- 7 Sec. 2-104.2. Do-Not-Resuscitate Orders. Every facility
- 8 licensed under this Act $\underline{\text{must}}$ $\underline{\text{shall}}$ establish a policy for the
- 9 implementation of physician orders limiting resuscitation such
- 10 as those commonly referred to as "Do-Not-Resuscitate" orders.
- 11 This policy may only prescribe the format, method of
- 12 documentation and duration of any physician orders limiting
- 13 resuscitation. Any orders under this policy <u>must</u> shall be
- 14 honored by the facility. The Department of Public Health
- Uniform DNR Order form or a copy of that form shall be honored
- 16 by the facility.
