Amends the Environmental Protection Act. Makes a technical change in a Section concerning sulfur dioxide emission standards.

1 AN ACT in relation to environmental safety.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Environmental Protection Act is amended by changing Section 9.2 as follows:
- 6 (415 ILCS 5/9.2) (from Ch. 111 1/2, par. 1009.2)
- 7 Sec. 9.2. Sulfur dioxide emission standards.
- 8 (a) (Blank.)
- In granting any alternative emission standard or 9 variance relating to sulfur dioxide emissions from a 10 coal-burning stationary source, the Board may require the use 11 of Illinois coal as a condition of the such alternative 12 standard or variance, provided that the Board determines that 13 14 Illinois coal of the proper quality is available and competitive in price; such determination shall include 15 consideration of the cost of pollution control equipment and 16 17 the economic impact on the Illinois coal mining industry.
