AN ACT in relation to driver licensing.

2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, 3 represented in the General Assembly:

Section 5. The Illinois Vehicle Code is amended by changing
Section 6-100 as follows:

6 (625 ILCS 5/6-100) (from Ch. 95 1/2, par. 6-100)

Sec. 6-100. Definitions. For the purposes of this Chapter,
the following words shall have the meanings ascribed to them:

9 (a) Application Process. The process of obtaining a 10 driver's license, identification card, or permit. The process 11 begins when a person enters a Secretary of State Driver 12 Services facility and requests a driver's license, 13 identification card or permit.

(b) Conviction. A final adjudication of guilty by a court
of competent jurisdiction either after a bench trial, trial by
jury, plea of guilty, order of forfeiture, or default.

17 (c) Identification Card. A document made or issued by or under the authority of the United States Government, the State 18 19 of Illinois or any other state or political subdivision 20 thereof, or governmental any or quasi-governmental organization that, when completed with information concerning 21 22 the individual, is of a type intended or commonly accepted for the purpose of identifying the individual. 23
