1 AN ACT concerning probate law.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Probate Act of 1975 is amended by changing
- 5 Section 1-4 as follows:
- 6 (755 ILCS 5/1-4) (from Ch. 110 1/2, par. 1-4)
- 7 Sec. 1-4. Pleadings.) On the court's own motion or on
- 8 motion of any interested person, before or during any hearing,
- 9 any person who desires to oppose the entry of an order or
- judgment <u>must</u> shall file, as directed by the court, a pleading
- 11 disclosing the grounds of opposition.
