Amends the Illinois Controlled Substances Act. Makes grammatical changes in the statute relating to the unlawful delivery of a controlled substance to a pregnant woman.

## Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, 2 represented in the General Assembly: 3

- Section 5. The Illinois Controlled Substances Act is 4 amended by changing Section 407.2 as follows: 5
- (720 ILCS 570/407.2) (from Ch. 56 1/2, par. 1407.2)
- 7 Sec. 407.2. Delivery of a controlled substance to a 8 pregnant woman.
- (a) Any person who violates subsection (a) of Section 401 9 10 of this Act by delivering a controlled substance to a woman he or she knows to be pregnant may be sentenced to imprisonment 11 for a term twice the maximum amount authorized by Section 401 12
- 14 (b) Any person who delivers an amount of a controlled
- 15 substance set forth in subsections (c) and (d) of Section 401
- of this Act to a woman he or she knows to be pregnant commits a 16
- 17 Class 1 felony. The fine for a violation of this subsection (b)
- shall not be more than \$250,000. 18

of this Act.
