SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

New Act

Creates the College and University Electronic Textbook Act. Upon request, requires a publisher of a textbook that is adopted for instructional use at a college or university to furnish the college or university with an electronic version of the textbook if the textbook is for a literary subject or, for a textbook for a nonliterary subject, if the technology is available to convert the textbook directly to a format compatible with braille translation software. Provides that a publisher may not charge a price for this electronic version that exceeds the price it charges for the print or electronic media version of the textbook. Effective immediately.

1 AN ACT concerning higher education.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- 4 Section 1. Short title. This Act may be cited as the
- 5 College and University Electronic Textbook Act.
- 6 Section 5. Definitions. As used in this Act:
- 7 "College or university" means a degree or
- 8 certificate-granting public or private college, university,
- 9 junior college, or community college located in this State.
- 10 "Textbook" includes a text published in electronic media
- 11 that is used for instructional purposes.
- 12 Section 10. Electronic version of textbook required to be 13 furnished. Upon request, a publisher of a textbook that is adopted for instructional use at a college or university shall 14 furnish the college or university with an electronic version of 15 16 the textbook if the textbook is for a literary subject or, for a textbook for a nonliterary subject, if the technology is 17 18 available to convert the textbook directly to a format compatible with braille translation software.
