SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

10 ILCS 5/19-1	from Ch. 46, par. 19	-1

Amends the Election Code. Permits a person to vote by absentee ballot on the basis that he or she is 65 years old or older.

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AN ACT concerning elections.

2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, 3 represented in the General Assembly:

4 Section 5. The Election Code is amended by changing 5 Sections 19-1, 19-2, 19-3, and 19-5 as follows:

6 (10 ILCS 5/19-1) (from Ch. 46, par. 19-1)

7 Sec. 19-1. Any qualified elector of the State of Illinois 8 having duly registered where such registration is required who is of the age of 65 or more years or who expects to be absent 9 from the county in which he is a qualified elector or who 10 because of being appointed a judge of election in a precinct 11 other than the precinct in which he resides or who because of 12 physical incapacity or the tenets of his religion in the 13 14 observance of a religious holiday or who because of election 15 duties for the office of an Election Authority or the State Board of Elections or who because of election duties for a law 16 17 enforcement agency, including but not limited to the offices of the Attorney General, a State's Attorney, a United States 18 Attorney, or a State, county, or municipal police department, 19 or who, because he is temporarily abiding outside the precinct 20 in which he is registered to vote due to the fact he is a 21 22 student attending an institution of higher education or who is 23 serving as a sequestered juror on a State or federal jury, will be unable to be present at the polls on the day of holding any 24 25 special, general or primary election at which any presidential 26 preference is indicated or any candidates are chosen or elected, for any congressional, State, district, county, town, 27 28 city, village, precinct or judicial offices or at which questions of public policy are submitted, may vote at such 29 30 election as hereinafter in this Article provided.

31 Each Election Authority, law enforcement agency, and the 32 State Board of Elections shall compile and keep current a list – 2 – LRB093 19983 JAM 45727 b

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of his or its officers or employees who are eligible to vote
 under this Article by reason of election duties.

For purposes of this Article 19, a physically incapacitated voter marks his or her ballot "personally" when the voter exercises his or her physical abilities to their reasonable limit in marking the ballot, and marking personally may include instructing the person assisting the incapacitated voter when giving such instruction represents the reasonable limit of the physical abilities.

Sec. 19-2. Any elector as defined in Section 19-1 who is of 12 the age of 65 or older or who is expecting to be absent from the 13 county of his residence or any such elector who because of 14 15 being appointed a judge of election in a precinct other than the precinct in which he resides or who because of physical 16 incapacity or the tenets of his religion in the observance of a 17 18 religious holiday or who because of election duties for the 19 office of an Election Authority, the State Board of Elections, or a law enforcement agency will be unable to be present at the 20 polls on the day of such election may by mail, not more than 40 21 22 nor less than 5 days prior to the date of such election, or by personal delivery not more than 40 nor less than one day prior 23 to the date of such election, make application to the county 24 25 clerk or to the Board of Election Commissioners for an official 26 ballot for the voter's precinct to be voted at such election. In the case of a voter who is voting absentee by reason of physical incapacity, marking a ballot in secret includes marking a ballot with the assistance of another individual,

other than a candidate whose name appears on the ballot (unless the voter is the spouse or a parent, child, brother, or sister of the candidate), the voter's employer, an agent of that employer, or an officer or agent of the voter's union, when the voter's physical incapacity necessitates such assistance.

6 Provided, that if the ballot enclosed is to be voted at a 7 primary election, the certification shall designate the name of 8 the political party with which the voter is affiliated.

9 In addition to the above, the election authority shall provide printed slips giving full instructions regarding the 10 11 manner of marking and returning the ballot in order that the 12 same may be counted, and shall furnish one of such printed 13 slips to each of such applicants at the same time the ballot is delivered to him. Such instructions shall include the following 14 15 statement: "In signing the certification on the absentee ballot 16 envelope, you are attesting that you personally marked this 17 absentee ballot in secret. If you are physically unable to mark the ballot, a friend or relative may assist you after 18 19 completing the enclosed affidavit. Federal and State laws 20 prohibit a candidate whose name appears on the ballot (unless you are the spouse or a parent, child, brother, or sister of 21 the candidate), your employer, your employer's agent or an 22 23 officer or agent of your union from assisting physically 24 disabled voters."

In addition to the above, if a ballot to be provided to an 25 26 elector pursuant to this Section contains a public question 27 described in subsection (b) of Section 28-6 and the territory 28 concerning which the question is to be submitted is not 29 described on the ballot due to the space limitations of such 30 ballot, the election authority shall provide a printed copy of 31 a notice of the public question, which shall include a 32 description of the territory in the manner required by Section 16-7. The notice shall be furnished to the elector at the same 33 time the ballot is delivered to the elector. 34
