Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

The sum of \$190,000,000, or so much thereof 4 5 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Federal Student Loan Fund to the Illinois Student Assistance Commission for 6 7 distribution when necessary as a result of the following: for guarantees of loans that are uncollectable, for collection 8 payments to the Student Loan Operating Fund as required under 9 10 agreements with the United States Secretary of Education, for payment to the Student Loan Operating Fund for Default 11 Aversion Fees, and for other distributions as necessary and 12 provided for under the Federal Higher Education Act. 13
 - Section 65. - 2 Section 105. The sum of \$2,100,000, or so much thereof

- 4 Fund to the Illinois Student Assistance Commission for
- 5 distribution as grants for Cooperative Work Study Programs to
- 6 institutions of higher education.
- 7 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect on July 1,
