A BILL FOR

1 AN ACT concerning appropriations.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented**
3 **in the General Assembly:**

4 ARTICLE 1

5 Section 5. The following amounts, or so much of those
6 amounts as may be necessary, respectively, are appropriated
7 from the General Revenue Fund to the Illinois Student
8 Assistance Commission for its ordinary and contingent
9 expenses:

19 Section 15. The sum of \$338,699,800, or so much thereof
20 as may be necessary, is appropriated to the Illinois Student
21 Assistance Commission from the General Revenue Fund for
22 payment of grant awards to students eligible to receive such
23 awards, as provided by law.

24 Section 20. The following named amount, or so much
25 thereof as may be necessary, respectively, is appropriated
26 from the Monetary Award Program Reserve Fund to the Illinois
27 Student Assistance Commission for the following purpose:

1 Section 25. The following named amounts, or so much
 2 thereof as may be necessary, respectively, are appropriated
 3 from the General Revenue Fund to the Illinois Student
 4 Assistance Commission for the following purposes:

6 For payment of matching grants to Illinois
 7 institutions to supplement scholarship
 8 programs, as provided by law\$950,000

9 For payment of Merit Recognition Scholarships
 10 to undergraduate students under the Merit
 11 Recognition Scholarship Program provided
 12 for in Section 31 of the Higher Education
 13 Student Assistance Act5,400,000

14 For the payment of scholarships to students
 15 who are children of policemen or firemen
 16 killed in the line of duty, or who are
 17 dependents of correctional officers killed
 18 or permanently disabled in the line of
 19 duty, as provided by law350,000

20 For payment of Illinois National Guard and
 21 Naval Militia Scholarships at
 22 State-controlled universities and public
 23 community colleges in Illinois to students
 24 eligible to receive such awards, as
 25 provided by law4,500,000

26 For payment of military Veterans' scholarships
 27 at State-controlled universities and at
 28 public community colleges for students
 29 eligible, as provided by law19,230,000

30 For payment of Minority Teacher Scholarships3,100,000

31 For payment of Illinois Incentive for Access
 32 grants, as provided by law7,200,000

33 For Teach for America450,000

1 Total \$41,180,000

2 Section 30. The sum of \$20,000, or so much thereof as
3 may be necessary, is appropriated from the National Guard
4 Grant Fund to the Illinois Student Assistance Commission for
5 payment of military veterans' scholarships at state-
6 controlled universities and at public community colleges for
7 students eligible, as provided by law.

8 Section 35. The sum of \$500,000, or so much thereof as
9 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue
10 Fund to the Illinois Student Assistance Commission for the
11 Loan Repayment for Teachers Program.

12 Section 45. The following named amount, or so much
13 thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General
14 Revenue Fund to the Illinois Student Assistance Commission
15 for the following purpose:

16 Grants and Scholarships
17 For payment of Illinois Future Teacher
18 Corps Scholarships, as provided by law7,000,000

19 Section 50. The following named amount, or so much
20 thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the
21 Contracts and Grants Fund to the Illinois Student Assistance
22 Commission for the following purpose:

23 To support outreach and training activities50,000

24 Section 55. The following named amount, or so much
25 thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the
26 Optometric Licensing and Disciplinary Board Fund to the
27 Illinois Student Assistance Commission for the following
28 purpose:

29 Grants and Scholarships

1 For payment of scholarships for the
 2 Optometric Education Scholarship
 3 Program, as provided by law50,000

4 Section 60. The sum of \$190,000,000, or so much thereof
 5 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Federal Student
 6 Loan Fund to the Illinois Student Assistance Commission for
 7 distribution when necessary as a result of the following: for
 8 guarantees of loans that are uncollectable, for collection
 9 payments to the Student Loan Operating Fund as required under
 10 agreements with the United States Secretary of Education, for
 11 payment to the Student Loan Operating Fund for Default
 12 Aversion Fees, and for other distributions as necessary and
 13 provided for under the Federal Higher Education Act.

14 Section 65. The sum of \$24,000,000, or so much thereof
 15 as may be necessary, is appropriated to the Illinois Student
 16 Assistance Commission from the Student Loan Operating Fund
 17 for distribution as necessary for the following: for payment
 18 of collection agency fees associated with collection
 19 activities for Federal Family Education Loans, for Default
 20 Aversion Fee reversals, and for distributions as necessary
 21 and provided for under the Federal Higher Education Act.

22 Section 70. The sum of \$5,000,000, or so much thereof as
 23 may be necessary, is appropriated to the Illinois Student
 24 Assistance Commission from the Student Loan Operating Fund
 25 for costs associated with Federal Loan System Development and
 26 Maintenance.

27 Section 75. The sum of \$300,000, or so much of that
 28 amount as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Accounts
 29 Receivable Fund to the Illinois Student Assistance Commission
 30 for costs associated with the collection of delinquent

1 scholarship awards pursuant to the Illinois State Collection
2 Act of 1986.

3 Section 80. The following named amount, or so much
4 thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Federal
5 Student Assistance Scholarship Fund to the Illinois Student
6 Assistance Commission for the following purpose:

7 For payment of Robert C. Byrd
8 Honors Scholarships\$1,400,000

9 Section 85. The sum of \$70,000, or so much thereof as
10 may be necessary, is appropriated to the Illinois Student
11 Assistance Commission from the University Grant Fund for
12 payment of grants for the Higher Education License Plate
13 Program, as provided by law.

14 Section 90. The following named amount, or so much
15 thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Federal
16 Student Assistance Scholarship Fund to the Illinois Student
17 Assistance Commission for the following purpose:

18 For transferring repayment funds collected
19 under the Paul Douglas Teacher Scholarship
20 Program to the U.S. Treasury 400,000

21 Section 95. The sum of \$120,100, or so much thereof as
22 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue
23 Fund to the Illinois Student Assistance Commission for
24 awarding scholarships to qualifying graduates of the
25 Lincoln's Challenge Program.

26 Section 100. The sum of \$2,000,000, or so much thereof
27 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue
28 Fund to the Illinois Student Assistance Commission for
29 distribution as grants authorized by the Illinois Consortium

1 for Educational Opportunity Act.

2 Section 105. The sum of \$2,100,000, or so much thereof
3 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue
4 Fund to the Illinois Student Assistance Commission for
5 distribution as grants for Cooperative Work Study Programs to
6 institutions of higher education.

7 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect on July 1,
8 2004.
