# Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

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#### ARTICLE 1

Section 1. The sum of \$150,000, or so much thereof as 16 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Illinois Historic 17 Sites Fund to the Historic Preservation Agency for awards and 18 grants for historic preservation programs made either 19 independently or in cooperation with the Federal Government 20 any agency thereof, any municipal corporation, 21 or or political subdivision of the State, or with any public or 22 private corporation, organization, or individual. 23

The sum of \$90,000, or so much thereof as 24 Section 3b. may be necessary and as remains unexpended at the close of 25 business on June 30, 2004, from a reappropriation heretofore 26 27 made in Article 1, Section 3a of Public Act 93-0093, as amended, is reappropriated from the Illinois Historic Sites 28 29 Fund to the Historic Preservation Agency for awards and 30 grants for historic preservation programs made either independently or in cooperation with the Federal Government 31 or any agency thereof, any municipal corporation, or 32

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3 Section 3c. The sum of \$50,000, or so much thereof as may be necessary and as remains unexpended at the close of 4 5 business on June 30, 2004, from a reappropriation heretofore made in Article 1, Section 3b of Public Act 93-0093, as 6 7 amended, is reappropriated from the Illinois Historic Sites Fund to the Historic Preservation Agency for awards and 8 9 grants for historic preservation programs made either 10 independently or in cooperation with the Federal Government agency thereof, any municipal corporation, 11 or any or political subdivision of the State, or with any public or 12 private corporation, organization, or individual. 13

The sum of \$50,000, or so much thereof as 14 Section 3d. may be necessary and as remains unexpended at the close of 15 business on June 30, 2004, from a reappropriation heretofore 16 made in Article 1, Section 3d of Public Act 93-0093, as 17 18 amended, is reappropriated from the General Revenue Fund to the Historic Preservation Agency to make Illinois Heritage 19 Grants for the purpose of planning, survey, rehabilitation, 20 restoration, reconstruction, landscaping and acquisition of 21 22 Illinois properties designated on the National Register of 23 Historic Places or as a landmark based on a county or 24 municipal ordinance or those located within certain historic 25 districts deemed historically significant.

Section 4a. The sum of \$200,000 or so much thereof as may be necessary is appropriated from the Illinois Historic Sites Fund to the Historic Preservation Agency for the ordinary and contingent expenses of the Administrative Services division for costs associated with but not limited to Union Station, the Old State Capitol and the Old Journal Register Building.

Section 5a. The sum of \$600,000, or so much thereof as 3 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Illinois Historic 4 5 Sites Fund to the Historic Preservation Agency for operations, maintenance, repairs, permanent improvements, 6 special events, and all other costs related to the operation 7 of Illinois Historic Sites and only to the extent which 8 donations are received at Illinois State Historic Sites. 9

Section 5b. The sum of \$204,500, or so much thereof as 10 11 necessary, is appropriated to the Historic may be Preservation Agency from the General Revenue Fund for 12 and purposes including repairing, maintaining, 13 programs reconstructing, rehabilitating, replacing, fixed 14 assets, construction and development, studies, all costs 15 for 16 supplies, materials, labor, land acquisition and its related costs, services and other expenses at historic sites. 17

18 Section 6. The sum of \$245,000, or so much thereof as 19 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue 20 Fund to the Historic Preservation Agency for the operational 21 expenses of the Lewis and Clark Historic Site in Madison 22 County.

23 Section 7. The amounts appropriated for repairs and maintenance and other capital improvements in Section 5b of 24 this Article for repairs and/or replacements, and 25 miscellaneous capital improvements at the agency's various 26 27 historical sites, and are to include construction, 28 reconstruction, improvements, repairs and installation of capital facilities, costs of planning, supplies, materials, 29 30 and all other types of repairs and maintenance, and capital

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1 improvements.

No contract shall be entered into or obligation incurred for repairs and maintenance and other capital improvements from appropriations made in Section 5c of this Article until after the purposes and amounts have been approved in writing by the Governor.

7 Section 8. The sum of \$7,655,950, or so much thereof as 8 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Presidential 9 Library and Museum Operating Fund to the Historic 10 Preservation Agency to meet the ordinary and contingent 11 expenses of the Abraham Lincoln Presidential Library and 12 Museum in Springfield.

13 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect on July 1,14 2004.
