Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

ARTICLE 1 4 5 Section 5. Section 10. The sum of \$100,000, or so much thereof as

- 1 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Governor's Grant
- 2 Fund to the Office of the Governor to be expended in
- 3 accordance with the terms and conditions upon which such
- 4 funds were received and in the exercise of the powers or
- 5 performance of the duties of the Office of the Governor.
- 6 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect on July 1,
