# Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

5	Section 1.1. The following named amounts, or so much

- Section 1.2. The sum of \$18,730,000, minus the amount 1 2 transferred to the State Employees' Retirement System pursuant to continuing appropriation authorized by the State 3 Pensions Fund Continuing Appropriation Act, is appropriated from the State Pensions Fund to the Board of Trustees of the 5 6 State Employees' Retirement System pursuant to the provisions of Section 8.12 of "An Act in relation to State finance", 7 approved June 10, 1919, as amended. 8
- 9 Section 2.1. The sum of \$26,430,000, or so much thereof 10 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue 11 Fund to the Board of Trustees of the Judges' Retirement 12 System for the State's Contribution, as provided by law.
- The sum of \$1,390,000, minus the amount 13 Section 2.2. 14 transferred to the Judges' Retirement System pursuant to continuing appropriation authorized by the State Pensions 15 Fund Continuing Appropriation Act, is appropriated from the 16 State Pensions Fund to the Board of Trustees of the Judges' 17 18 Retirement System pursuant to the provisions of Section 8.12 of "An Act in relation to State finance", approved June 10, 19 1919, as amended. 20
- Section 3.1. The sum of \$3,609,000, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund to the Board of Trustees of the General Assembly Retirement System for the State's Contribution, as provided by law.
- Section 3.2. The sum of \$270,000, minus the amount transferred to the General Assembly Retirement System pursuant to continuing appropriation authorized by the State Pensions Fund Continuing Appropriation Act, is appropriated from the State Pensions Fund to the Board of Trustees of the
