Makes appropriations and reappropriations to the Board of Trustees of Eastern Illinois University for various purposes, including ordinary and contingent expenses. Effective July 1, 2004.

1 AN ACT making appropriations and reappropriations.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

4	Section 5. The following named amounts, or so much
5	thereof as may be necessary, respectively, for the purposes
6	hereinafter named, are appropriated from the General Revenue
7	Fund to the Board of Trustees of Eastern Illinois University
8	to meet the ordinary and contingent expenses of the
9	University, including payment or reimbursement to the
10	University for personal services and related costs incurred
11	during the fiscal year ending June 30, 2005 and for personal
12	services and related costs accrued during fiscal year 2004
13	but remaining unpaid on June 30, 2004:
14	Personnel Services\$44,609,500
15	Contractual Services, 700,000
16	Commodities500,000
17	Equipment500,000
18	Telecommunications300,000
19	Total \$47,609,500

Section 10. The sum of \$185,946, or so much thereof as may be necessary and remains unexpended at the close of business on June 30, 2004, from a reappropriation heretofore made for such purpose in Article 9, Section 10 of Public Act 93-90, is reappropriated from the Capital Development Fund to the Board of Trustees of Eastern Illinois University for digitalization infrastructure for WEIU-TV. No contract shall be entered into or obligation incurred for any expenditure from the appropriation made in this Section until after the purposes and amounts have been approved in writing by the Governor.

Section 15. The sum of \$100,000, or so much thereof as 2 may be necessary and remains unexpended at the close of business on June 30, 2004, from a reappropriation heretofore made for such purpose in Article 9, Section 15 of Public Act 93-90, is reappropriated from the Capital Development Fund to 5 the Board of Trustees of Eastern Illinois University for digitalization infrastructure for WEIU-TV, in addition to 7 amounts otherwise appropriated for such purpose. No contract 8 shall be entered into or obligation incurred for any 9 expenditure from the appropriation made in this Section until 10 after the purposes and amounts have been approved in writing by the Governor. 12

Section 20. The sum of \$393,294, or so much thereof as may be necessary and remains unexpended at the close of business on June 30, 2004, from a reappropriation heretofore made for such purpose in Article 9, Section 20 of Public Act 93-90, is reappropriated from the Capital Development Fund to the Board of Trustees of Eastern Illinois University to purchase equipment for the renovation and expansion of Booth No contract shall be entered into or obligation Library. incurred for any expenditure from the appropriation made in this Section until after the purposes and amounts have been approved in writing by the Governor.

Section 25. The sum of \$5,430,400, or so much thereof as may be necessary and remains unexpended at the close of business on June 30, 2004, from a reappropriation heretofore made for such purpose in Article 9, Section 25 of Public Act 93-90, is reappropriated from the Capital Development Fund to the Board of Trustees of Eastern Illinois University to purchase equipment for the renovation and expansion of the Fine Arts Center. No contract shall be entered into or obligation incurred for any expenditure from the Governor.
