**A BILL FOR**

1 AN ACT concerning appropriations.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented**  
3 **in the General Assembly:**

4 Section 5. The following named sums, or so much thereof  
5 as may be necessary, respectively, are appropriated to the  
6 Attorney General to meet the ordinary and contingent expenses  
7 of the following division of the Office of the Attorney  
8 General:

27 Section 10. The sum of \$1,050,000, or so much thereof as  
28 is available for use by the Attorney General, is appropriated  
29 to the Attorney General from the Illinois Gaming Law  
30 Enforcement Fund for State law enforcement purposes.

1 Section 15. The following named sums, or so much thereof  
 2 as may be necessary, respectively, are appropriated from the  
 3 Asbestos Abatement Fund to the Attorney General to meet the  
 4 ordinary and contingent expenses of the Environmental  
 5 Enforcement-Asbestos Litigation Division:

19 Section 20. The amount of \$3,500,000, or so much thereof  
 20 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Attorney  
 21 General Court Ordered and Voluntary Compliance Payment  
 22 Projects Fund to the Office of the Attorney General for use,  
 23 subject to pertinent court order or agreement, in the  
 24 performance of any function pertaining to the exercise of the  
 25 duties of the Attorney General, including State law  
 26 enforcement and public education.

27 Section 25. The amount of \$950,000, or so much thereof  
 28 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Illinois  
 29 Charity Bureau Fund to the Office of the Attorney General to  
 30 enforce the provisions of the Solicitation for Charity Act  
 31 and to gather and disseminate information about charitable  
 32 trustees and organizations to the public.

1 Section 30. The amount of \$1,000,000, or so much thereof  
2 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Whistleblower  
3 Reward and Protection Fund to the Office of the Attorney  
4 General for State law enforcement purposes.

5 Section 35. The amount of \$900,000, or so much thereof  
6 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Capital  
7 Litigation Trust Fund to the Attorney General for financial  
8 support under the Capital Crimes Litigation Act.

9 Section 40. The amount of \$750,000, or so much thereof  
10 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Tobacco  
11 Settlement Recovery Fund to the Attorney General for the  
12 funding of a unit responsible for oversight, enforcement, and  
13 implementation of the Master Settlement Agreement entered in  
14 the case of People of the State of Illinois v. Philip Morris,  
15 et al. (Circuit Court of Cook County, No. 96L13146), for  
16 enforcement of the Tobacco Product Manufacturers' Escrow Act,  
17 and for handling remaining tobacco-related litigation.

18 Section 45. The amount of \$3,500,000, or so much thereof  
19 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Attorney  
20 General's State Projects and Court Ordered Distribution Fund  
21 to the Attorney General for payment of interagency  
22 agreements, for court-ordered distributions to third parties,  
23 and, subject to pertinent court order, for performance of any  
24 function pertaining to the exercise of the duties of the  
25 Attorney General, including State law enforcement and public  
26 education.

27 Section 50. The amount of \$100,000, or so much thereof  
28 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Attorney  
29 General's Grant Fund to the Office of the Attorney General to

1 be expended in accordance with the terms and conditions upon  
2 which those funds were received.

3 Section 55. The following named amounts, or so much  
4 thereof as may be necessary, respectively, for the objects  
5 and purposes named in this Section, are appropriated to the  
6 Attorney General to meet the ordinary and contingent expenses  
7 of the Attorney General:

24 Section 60. The amount of \$280,000, or so much thereof  
25 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Child Support  
26 Administrative Fund to the Office of the Attorney General for  
27 child support enforcement purposes.

28 Section 65. The amount of \$3,000,000, or so much thereof  
29 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Attorney  
30 General Federal Grant Fund to the Office of the Attorney  
31 General for funding for federal grants.

1           Section 70. The amount of \$500,000, or so much thereof  
2 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Sex Offender  
3 Management Board Fund to the Sex Offender Management Board  
4 for the purposes authorized by the Sex Offender Management  
5 Board Act including, but not limited to, sex offender  
6 evaluation, treatment, and monitoring programs and grants.  
7 Funding received from private sources is to be expended in  
8 accordance with the terms and conditions placed upon the  
9 funding.

10           Section 75. The amount of \$50,000, or so much thereof as  
11 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Statewide Grand  
12 Jury Prosecution Fund to the Office of the Attorney General  
13 for expenses incurred in criminal prosecutions arising under  
14 the Statewide Grand Jury Act.

15           Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect July 1,  
16 2004.
