## SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

Makes FY05 appropriations to the Supreme Court for the ordinary and contingent expenses of certain officers of the court system of Illinois, the Supreme Court, the Appellate Courts, the Circuit Court, the Administrative Office of the Illinois Courts, the Illinois Courts Commission, Mandatory Arbitration Programs, the Foreign Language Interpreter Program, and lawyers' assistance programs. Effective July 1, 2004.

- Section 30. The sum of \$64,900, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated to the Supreme Court for the contingent expenses of the Illinois Courts Commission.
- Section 35. The sum of \$12,792,000, or so much thereof 9 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Mandatory 10 Arbitration Fund to the Supreme Court for Mandatory 11 Arbitration Programs.
- Section 40. The sum of \$116,800, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Foreign Language Interpreter Fund to the Supreme Court for the Foreign Language Interpreter Program.
- Section 45. The sum of \$728,000, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Lawyers' Assistance Program Fund to the Supreme Court for lawyers' assistance programs.
- 20 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect July 1, 21 2004.
