20 RESOLVED ΒY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE NINETY-THIRD GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ILLINOIS, that 21 we request that the United States Congress thoroughly and 22 23 completely investigate allegations of sexual harassment and sexual assault in all branches of the military and all 24 military academies, especially the United States Air Force 25 Academy in Colorado Springs, Colorado; and be it further 26

27 RESOLVED, That the we request that the charter for the 28 panel known as the Defense Department Advisory Committee on 29 Women in the Services be once again renewed; and be it 30 further
