1 HOUSE RESOLUTION WHEREAS, According to Federal Reserve data, in 2001 2 Americans owed more than \$500 billion in outstanding auto loans 3 4 and paid close to \$45 billion in interest on these auto loans; 5 and WHEREAS, According to the Consumer Federation of America, 6 7 in their 2003 Report, "The Hidden Mark-up of Auto Loans," 8 African-Americans and Hispanics pay higher finance interest 9 rates than other borrowers; and 10 WHEREAS, Discrepancies finance in rates between 11 African-Americans and Hispanics and other consumers cannot be explained by difference of creditworthiness; and 12 13 WHEREAS, In 2001, DaimlerChrysler ranked third among the top ten companies in auto finance; and 14 15 WHEREAS, Data shows that the average annual rate of interest on vehicle loans for African-American and Hispanic 16 households is higher than that of other households; and 17 WHEREAS, 35 percent of African-American households held 18 19 auto loans averaging a little more than \$15,000 at an average 20 interest rate of a little more than 10 percent; thus paying 21 approximately \$6 billion in interest annually; and WHEREAS, Elected officials and civic leaders in Chicago and 22 23 Cook County have called for a nationwide boycott against 24 DaimlerChrysler as a result of racial discrimination that 25 included systematic denial of financing to African-Americans at two local dealerships in Chicago neighborhoods and making 26 27 racially insensitive remarks by corporate executives and

employees; therefore, be it

RESOLVED, BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE NINETY-THIRD GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ILLINOIS, that we call upon DaimlerChrysler Corporation and Chrysler Financial Corporation to halt all patterns and practices of racial discrimination, including discriminatory lending practices; and to take corrective action including employment termination of executives who have made racially insensitive remarks and increase the number of minority-owned dealerships and the number of minorities in executive positions; and be it further
