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## HOUSE RESOLUTION

2 WHEREAS, The House Special Committee on Fee-For-Service 3 Initiatives has held three open hearings on the Department of 4 Human Services' proposal to adopt a fee-for-service 5 methodology to pay providers for serving the State's clients 6 with problems of substance abuse, developmental disability, 7 and mental illness; and

8 WHEREAS, The Committee appreciates the willingness of the 9 Governor's Office of Management and Budget and the Department 10 of Human Services to work with provider groups to ensure a 11 smooth transition to the new payment methodology; and

12 WHEREAS, The Committee, while supporting the 13 fee-for-service methodology, remains concerned that the 14 Department's transition schedule could jeopardize treatment 15 for these most vulnerable populations; and

16 WHEREAS, The Committee believes the Department must show it 17 has the infrastructure capacity and field-tested experience 18 before a wholesale shift to the new system; therefore, be it

HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF 19 RESOLVED, ΒY THE THE NINETY-THIRD GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ILLINOIS, that 20 21 the Committee urges the Department of Human Services to make 22 periodic progress reports to the Committee over the next 23 several months, specifically including reports in September, 24 October, November, and December of 2004; and be it further

RESOLVED, That the Committee urges the General Assembly to adopt an operational budget for the Department of Human Services that reflects only the first six months of funding for the coming fiscal year, while appropriating the full year of grant lines.
