Division Commander; Lieutenant, Supp. Services Coordinator; Assistant Chief of Support Services; Assistant Chief of Operations; and finally becoming Chief of Police in 1995; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Clark is a member of many professional and civic organizations including the Illinois/International Association of Chiefs of Police, the F.B.I. National Academy Associates of Illinois where he was past president of the Southern Division, McLean County Crimestoppers where he was a past Police Coordinator, Countering Domestic and Sexual Violence Advisory Board, the Normal Lions Club where he was a past president, the Normal Employees Assistance Program Committee Chairman, and the Normal Employee Credit Union where he was a past president, and he has served as a guest speaker
