HOUSE RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, Brandon Runge has successfully completed all of the requirements and will be awarded the rank of Eagle Scout at a ceremony on September 5, 2004; taking into consideration the degree of dedication and hard work it takes to successfully complete the required fields to become an Eagle Scout, it is obvious that Mr. Runge has shown maturity and dedication to becoming a pillar of society and is an inspiration to all the members of the General Assembly and his own community; therefore be it
