WHEREAS, He is a 40-year Farm Bureau member; he joined the Randolph County Farm Bureau Board in 1958, serving on the Young Farmers, Local Affairs, Public Relations, Sports, Legislative, and Viewpoint Committees; Glenn was county Farm Bureau President for five years, and a delegate to the annual IFB meetings; and

WHEREAS, He served on the Illinois Soybean Association Board from 1989 to 1993, acting as Vice President and Secretary, as well as Chairman of the Domestic Promotions Committee; he served two years as President of the Randolph County Pork Producers Board and received the Superior Pork Award; he was named Master Farmer by Prairie Farmer Magazine in 1989; and

WHEREAS, He has participated in American Farm Bureau's Adopt-A-Scientist program; he has served as a county board member on the Farmers Home Administration; he has also served on the Randolph County Soil Conservation Service Board; he is a former leader of the Wine Hill Toppers 4-H Club, having led for
