2	AMENDMENT NO Amend Senate Bill 132 by replacing
3	everything after the enacting clause with the following:
4 5	"Section 5. The Counties Code is amended by adding Division 1-7 to Article 1 as follows:
6 7	(55 ILCS 5/Art. 1 Div. 1-7 heading new) <u>Division 1-7. Ineligibility for Elected County Office</u>
8	(55 ILCS 5/1-7005 new)
9	Sec. 1-7005. Ineligibility for elected county office. A
10	person is not eligible for an elective county office if that
11	person is in arrears in the payment of a tax or other
12	indebtedness due to the county or has been convicted in any
13	court located in the United States of any infamous crime,
14	bribery, perjury, or other felony.
15	Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon
16	becoming law.".
