- 3 represented in the General Assembly:
- 4 Section 5. The Counties Code is amended by changing
- 5 Section 3-6020 as follows:
- 6 (55 ILCS 5/3-6020) (from Ch. 34, par. 3-6020)
- 7 Sec. 3-6020. Contempt of court; damages. The
- 8 disobedience of any sheriff to perform the command of any
- 9 warrant, process, order or judgment legally issued to him or
- 10 her, shall be deemed a contempt of the court that issued the
- same, and may be punished accordingly; and he or she shall be
- 12 liable to the party aggrieved for all damages occasioned
- 13 thereby. <u>No sheriff shall be civilly liable for serving, as</u>
- 14 <u>directed by the court, any warrant, order, process, or</u>
- judgment that has been issued or affirmed by a court of the
- 16 State of Illinois and that is valid on its face, unless the
- 17 <u>service involved willful or wanton misconduct by the sheriff.</u>
