Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,represented in the General Assembly:

Purchase of additional service credit. 7 8 (a) This Section applies only to a person who (i) served as a principal for at least 5 years, (ii) left service due to 9 a failure to receive a new contract from the local school 10 council, (iii) elected the early retirement without discount 11 option under Section 17-116.1, (iv) began receiving a 12 retirement pension before 1992, and (v) has more than 30 13 14 years of service credit.

15 (b) An eligible person may apply in writing to the Board 16 to establish an additional 5 years of creditable service in 17 the Fund. The application must be received by the Board 18 within 90 days following the effective date of this Section, 19 and must be accompanied by payment of the amount determined 20 under subsection (c).

(c) For each year of creditable service established 21 22 under this Section, the applicant must pay to the Fund a contribution consisting of 4% of the highest annual salary 23 rate that was used in the determination of the person's 24 retirement pension. The amount of the employee contribution 25 already paid by the person under Section 17-116.1 shall be 26 27 credited against the total contribution required under this 28 subsection.

29 (d) A person who has purchased any creditable service

The forfeiture of 7 creditable service under this subsection shall not entitle 8 9 the person to a refund of the contribution paid under this <u>Section.</u> 10 11 (f) A person who received any early retirement incentive under Section 17-116.3, 17-116.4, 17-116.5, or 17-116.6 may 12 not purchase additional creditable service under this 13 Section. 14 15 Section 90. The State Mandates Act is amended by adding Section 8.27 as follows: 16 17 (30 ILCS 805/8.27 new) Sec. 8.27. Exempt mandate. Notwithstanding Sections 6 18 19 and 8 of this Act, no reimbursement by the State is required for the implementation of any mandate created by this 20 21 amendatory Act of the 93rd General Assembly.
