AN ACT concerning criminal law.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,represented in the General Assembly:

Section 5. The Capital Crimes Litigation Act is amended
by changing Section 5 as follows:

8 Sec. 5. Appointment of trial counsel in death penalty cases. If an indigent defendant is charged with an offense 9 for which a sentence of death is authorized, and the State's 10 Attorney has not, at or before arraignment, filed 11 а certificate indicating he or she will not seek the death 12 13 penalty or stated on the record in open court that the death penalty will not be sought, the trial court shall immediately 14 appoint the Public Defender, or such other qualified attorney 15 16 or attorneys as the Illinois Supreme Court shall by rule provide, to represent the defendant as trial counsel. If the 17 18 Public Defender is appointed, he or she shall immediately 19 assign an such attorney or attorneys who are public defenders 20 to represent the defendant. The counsel shall meet the qualifications as the Supreme Court shall by rule provide. 21 (Source: P.A. 91-589, eff. 1-1-00.) 22
