1 Governor, 4 shall be appointed for terms to expire on the third Monday in January, 1999, and 3 shall be appointed for 2 terms to expire on the third Monday in January, 2001. If the 3 4 Senate is not in session on the effective date of this 5 Article, or if a vacancy in an appointive membership occurs 6 at a time when the Senate is not in session, the Governor 7 shall make temporary appointments until the next meeting of 8 the Senate when he shall nominate persons to fill such 9 memberships for the remainder of their respective terms. 10 more than 4 of the members appointed by the Governor shall be 11 affiliated with the same political party. Each member appointed by the Governor must be a resident of this State. 12 A failure to meet or maintain this residency requirement 13 constitutes a resignation from and creates a vacancy in the 14 Board. Upon the expiration of the terms of members appointed 15 16 by the Governor, their respective successors shall appointed for terms of 6 years from the third Monday in 17 January of each odd-numbered year.
