- 1 AN ACT concerning immigrant assistance.
- 2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,
- 3 represented in the General Assembly:
- 4 Section 5. The Attorney General Act is amended by adding
- 5 Section 6.6 as follows:
- 6 (15 ILCS 205/6.6 new)
- 7 <u>Sec. 6.6. Immigrant Assistance Program.</u>
- 8 (a) Purpose and policy. The immigrant population of the
- 9 State of Illinois constitutes a significant portion of the
- 10 population of the State. These immigrants often require
- 11 <u>assistance in order to obtain the government services to</u>
- 12 which they are entitled under the law. It is imperative that
- 13 State government is aware of the needs of the State's
- 14 <u>immigrant community and sensitive to the barriers that may</u>
- 15 prevent them from seeking and obtaining services. The Office
- 16 of the Attorney General should be equipped to assist
- 17 <u>immigrants by increasing accessibility to the Office and</u>
- 18 providing outreach services to the community, which will
- 19 serve to educate immigrants as to their rights and
- 20 <u>responsibilities as residents of the State.</u>
- 21 (b) Immigrant Assistance Program. Within the Office of
- 22 <u>the Attorney General, there shall be established an Immigrant</u>
- 23 <u>Assistance Program, which shall be charged with the</u>
- 24 <u>responsibility of assessing the needs of the State's</u>
- 25 <u>immigrant community with regard to access to government and</u>
- other services. In addition, the Immigrant Assistance Program
- 27 <u>shall be empowered to provide education and outreach services</u>
- 28 <u>to the immigrant community of the State, subject to funding</u>
- 29 <u>availability. These services may include, but are not limited</u>
- 30 <u>to, consumer issues, civil rights issues, employee rights,</u>
- 31 and other issues of particular interest to the immigrant

- 1 <u>communities in the State.</u>
- Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon 2
- 3 becoming law.
