- 2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,
- 3 represented in the General Assembly:
- 4 Section 5. The One Day Rest In Seven Act is amended by
- 5 changing Section 3 as follows:
- 6 (820 ILCS 140/3) (from Ch. 48, par. 8c)
- 7 Sec. 3. Every employer shall permit its employees who
- 8 are to work for 7 1/2 continuous hours or longer, except <u>as</u>
- 9 <u>otherwise</u> these specified in this Section, at least 20
- 10 minutes for a meal period beginning no later than 5 hours
- 11 after the start of the work period.
- 12 This Section does not apply to employees for whom meal
- 13 periods are established through the collective bargaining
- 14 process.
- This Section does not apply to employees who monitor
- 16 individuals with developmental disabilities or mental
- illness, or both, and who, in the course of those duties, are
- 18 required to be on call during an entire 8 hour work period;
- 19 however, those employees shall be allowed to eat a meal
- 20 during the 8 hour work period while continuing to monitor
- 21 those individuals.
